#### Session 1: July 22nd—Respect Life Issues

#### Session 2: July 29th—Theology of the Body

**English Youth & Young Adult Ministry Director Ann Marie Avansino** will give an overview of Theology of the Body materials by Ascension Press. Pope John Paul II devoted the first major teaching of his pontificate to developing and delivering what he called a Theology of the Body. The Theology of the Body covers such topics as the profound meaning and mystery of the body; the nature of our sexuality; our need for communion; and the authentic nature and purpose of marriage.
